Geographically just over half of our membership is Auckland based, with a quarter in the Wellington region, and the balance spread out across Aotearoa.

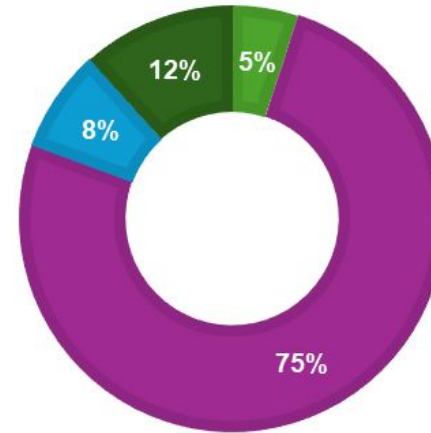
Our members comes from a very broad range of industries and organisational sizes.

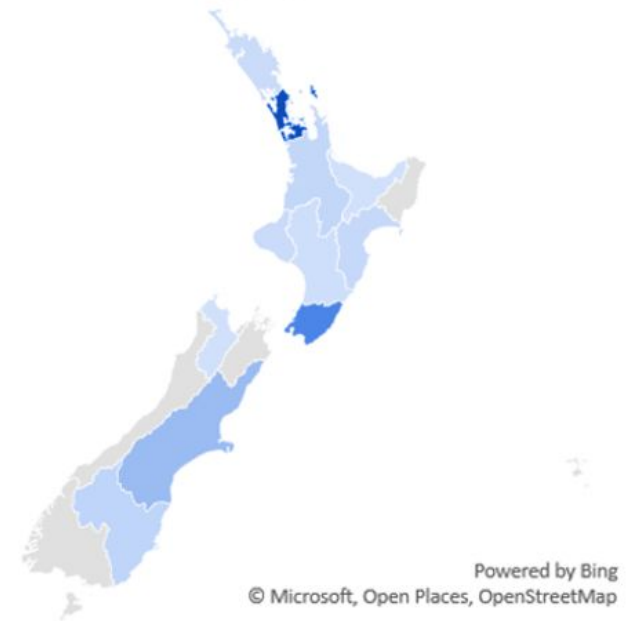
